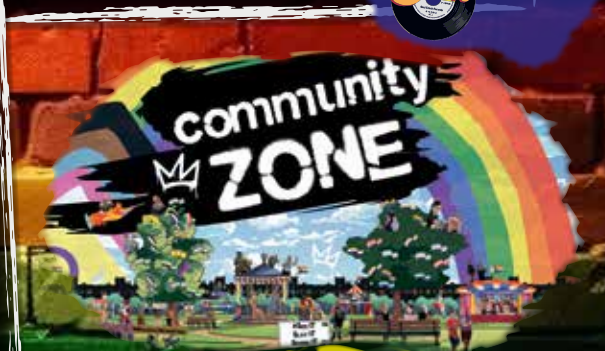

Site Rules

We run a strict challenge under 25 policy for alcohol.

If you are asked for ID when buying alcohol Take it as a compliment. Some of us beg for a time when we are asked for ID at a bar. You obviously have beautiful youthful looks

Strictly no psychoactive substances or legal highs.

Anyone found with legal highs will be removed from the site. We realise it's a phase you will grow out of it

No dangerous or hazardous items are allowed.

Anyone found with a weapon will be detained and reported to the police.
This is a Safe Space 4 All, Don't be a d* *k. Plus, the police are here, we won't have to walk far.

Only water is permitted. Drinks may be tested on entry.

If it's gin or vodka, we'll be giving straight to the drag queens.

Aerosols or gels in containers are permitted but may be tested on entry.

Lynx Africa will be thrown directly in the bin, and everybody told on the PA system it was yours.
This isn't a P.E. class in the 90s

No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought onto the site with you.

We have gone to great lengths to make sure there is a wide selection of drinks at our bars.

Dogs kept on leads, well behaved, poop scooped & binned not bushed.

Human pups are allowed too. And cats, and raccoons and wolves and bears even furrries too.

No disposable barbecues

There is some amazing food here. No need to cook your own badly (plus it smells).

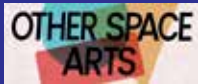


We have gone to great efforts to ensure the alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages are inclusive.
 Drinks by default will be served in paper cups however we strongly encourage you to purchase a reusable plastic pint glass from the merch stall or upon entry. This will be washed every time a new drink is purchased and is yours to take home at the end of the day to promote sustainability. You can also get drinking water from the bar. Any plastic cups you wish to leave after will be donated to other space arts & reused.

For food we have everything from traditional burgers & fish & chips, indian, scandinavian, jamaican and favourites like cakes & coffee. Even freshly made fudge & ice cream.
 There are many vegan options too. Please dispose of any rubbish in the many bins located around the site so that we can keep the event as sustainable as possible.

Seating & shaded area & wellness
 Located at the rear of the ferris wheel there is a shaded area to eat drink and recharge. We are also hosting three wellness sessions on the rabble rousers stage throughout the day, one to stretch off after the march, two keep fit sessions and also two yoga sessions in the cinema and talks tent.

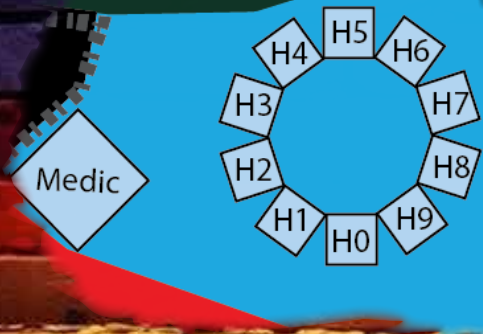

You're probably wondering why a Pride event is focused on sustainability. Well, I'm here to answer that. Sustainability is everyone's responsibility and in order to preserve our precious Alexandra Gardens, we decided that creating a sustainable event would be a great way to honour the environment while we celebrate all the beautiful humans too.

Working together with the RBWM Sustainability Team, we have managed to secure reusable drinkware to replace paper and plastic wastage. Any of these which are unwanted at the end of the day will be donated to other space arts & reused if you don't take it home. Think that's great? We also went out of our way to secure generators for our power, created Pride Guides from recycled paper Food? We got you covered. We have Vegan and Vegetarian options too.

This is the first Pride festival in Windsor and we aim to keep it going annually. In order to do that we need to ensure we have somewhere to return to, which is why we also have reinforced matting to protect the grass simultaneously creating more accessible paths for wheels.

We partnered with **Great Western Railway** to create eco-friendly travel options, along with **People2Places** providing lifts from the coach park beside Alexandra Gardens to the Parade - again, going hand-in-hand with accessibility options for all our visitors.

Taking pride in our community, we opened our stall bookings to local RBWM businesses and organisations, helping to support circular economic growth.

In fact, the RBWM Sustainability Team liked our ideas so much they awarded Sustainable Event Something which proud of and stand firm in



us with the Gold Award for 2025! we are mega something we delivering.

From Jacob Franklin,
Director of *Dragged Through Time*:



Notice Productions is youth-led drama company who makes films on issues that matter to young people.

When I proposed an LGBTQ focused film, I didn't know that it would lead to Notice Productions most ambitious project to date. We also didn't know we'd have the honour of premiering the film at the first ever Windsor & Eton Pride.

My film tells the story a boy, Isaac, who takes a family holiday to Windsor. While he really doesn't want to be there at first, the trip turns into an unexpected coming-of-age experience. Isaac finds himself journeying back to uncover 1000s of years of gay history. The history Isaac finds, through a range of vivid day-dreams, is not found in the Windsor museums. It is a history that is too often ignored. It is a history that explores the joy, the pain, the rebellion, the loss and the glory of the gay experience.

And it is a history that makes Isaac better understand who he is and where he has come from.

Dragged Through Time has been a true community undertaking. Alongside the Notice Productions cast, the film is proud to feature many members of the Pride Committee; locations provided by excellent community resources; support with production from talented locals; cameos from professional actors; and, of course, the legendary gay icon that is Ian McKellen.

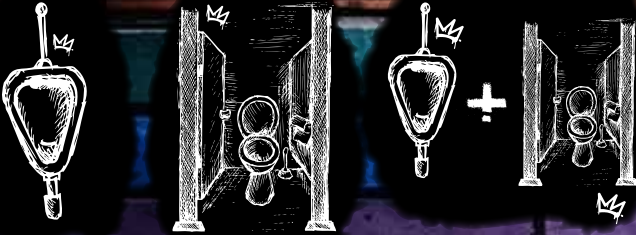

Windsor & Eton Pride has genderless toilets. But toilets have different furniture within them. At Windsor & Eton Pride we have **Sitting** and **Standing**. Anybody can use them and they are marked by these signs. Some of the toilet cabins have a mixture of both. We will leave it to you to decide where it goes. We also have a high dependancy unit (Changing Places) located next to the main bar. This has a hoist and full size medical bed for accessibility users. To use this facility speak to the volunteer nearby.
