This event is delivered by a not for profit charity run exclusively by skilled volunteers from the community and honestly it takes a lot of time and effort throughout the whole year.

On behalf of the whole volunteer committee we want to say **THANK YOU** to all our visitors because the 6000 of you that attended last year proved to us that the entire community was ready and waiting to celebrate Pride and demonstrate that everyone is welcome, safe and loved here.

The event in 2025 created a platform for the community to celebrate local artists and artisans, be creative and learn more about LGBTQIA+ issues through local charities and health organisations.

The truth it was nearly cancelled due to funding issues but we believed that the community needed this event and made personal sacrifices to make it happen.

Thankfully, by every measure, last year was a huge success! 6000 people attended from all demographics, from local youth groups to national treasures everybody had a good time and the feedback was overwhelmingly positive.

There were still a few things we wanted to improve based on your feedback. So this year the Karaoke tent is open longer, the main stage is full-size, we have even more bars and drinks options (including our very special Unicorn Juice by Indie Rabble), the food options, traders and artists have been carefully selected and we've put more effort into making the event as accessible as possible, from partnering with Shop Mobility to keeping the walk up entry free.

We are privileged Bones, the winner of Drag race UK 2025, is headlining and are bringing their entire Heavenly Bodies show with their drag sisters Flesh & LaBelle.

We've listened, you wanted a bigger say in who takes the stage. While Steve and Nathan curated a diverse mix of drag, comedy, and local legends, we introduced Golden Tickets to settle the "must-have" debates. Five acts, five automatic spots. **Here's your winners:**

Men Don't Have Nightmares (Steve's Choice)

Imagine Fleetwood Mac, The Last Dinner Party, and Muse tossed into a blender. This LGBTQIA+ band is pure magic. They're racing here from their festival debut at Latitude yesterday, let's give them a massive Windsor welcome!



LOSTCHILD (Nathan's Choice)

Dark, raw, and disarmingly honest electronic pop. Nathan's pick brings synth-led anthems designed for the outsiders. If you want to dance while feeling all the emotions, this is your musical home.



Sophie Hyphae (The Committee's Choice)

A true local gem. Expect shimmering synths and soaring vocals that tell stories of nature and human connection. Catch their impressionistic set on the bandstand for the perfect summer evening vibe.



The Cover Up (The Public's Choice)

You voted, we booked! Following in the footsteps of last year's favourites, The Cover Up are bringing indie anthems and 80s classics. Grab a pint of Unicorn Juice, find some lunch, and get ready for a site-wide singalong.



Erik Schön (The Public's Choice)

What's Pride without drag? Erik is pulling double duty: a family-friendly show on the bandstand this afternoon, followed by a steamy burlesque set in the Cabaret Tent for the adults. Two Erik Schön for the price of one?

Site Rules

We run a strict challenge under 25 policy for alcohol.

If you are asked for ID when buying alcohol Take it as a compliment. Some of us beg for a time when we are asked for ID at a bar. You obviously have beautiful youthful looks

Strictly no psychoactive substances or legal highs.

Anyone found with legal highs will be removed from the site. We realise it's a phase you will grow out of it

No dangerous or hazardous items are allowed.

Anyone found with a weapon will be detained and reported to the police. This is a Safe Space 4 All, Don't be a d**k. Plus, the police are here, we won't have to walk far.

Only water is permitted.

Drinks may be tested on entry. If it's gin or vodka, we'll be giving straight to the drag queens.

Aerosols or gels in containers are permitted but may be tested on entry.

Lynx Africa will be thrown directly in the bin, and everybody told on the PA system it was yours. This isn't a P.E. class in the 90s

No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought onto the site with you.

We have gone to great lengths to make sure there is a wide selection of drinks at our bars.

Dogs kept on leads, well behaved, poop scooped & binned not bushed.

Human pups are allowed too. And cats, and raccoons and wolves and bears even furrries too.

No disposable barbecues

There is some amazing food here. No need to cook your own badly (plus it smells).

No large rucksacks or suitcases are permitted:

We define a large rucksack as anything over A4 size. Unless you're a performing drag queen or king, they have luggage, and the kitchen sink, and that's fine.

No flares (it's not the 70's), No fireworks (unless you're Katy Perry, then you can bring one firework, it must go up, up, up and it must shoot across the sky)

No flyers for distribution.

We have to clean this site up, not you. The important stuff is in the Pride guide. Please read it. (like the official afterparty at the Scotch Bar).

No inflatables or large umbrellas,

Unless it looks like a Tardis from Dr Who. Rhianna can have one umbrella, ela, ela., ela & but she must be under it.

There are to be no goods for unauthorised trading

Traders on the site were handpicked we don't admit any riff raff. No Trading Pokemon cards unless its Pikachu

No portable laser equipment or pens are permitted.

Unless your Skrillek or Chase & Status, then you can bring some of them. But not all of them, you have too many.

No unofficial tabards or reflective jackets are allowed.

Our unicorn herder staff hi-vis are cool enough, we don't need more

No food hampers, or large amounts of food.

Fortnum & Mason hampers, that's overkill, we know it's Windsor but..... Only small amounts of food for you.

No bicycles, skateboards, or scooters.

A skatepark is down the road; it needs some love & repairs, but you can use it there and its free.

No Super Soakers or water pistols are allowed.

Yes, it will be HOT!, we hope, but save them for your garden, or the beach.

No drones are permitted.

The dressing-up type cos-play drones are welcome, though. Even protogens, Beep Boop.

No spray cans (paint).

Unless its on one of our t-shirts from the Windsor & Eton Pride stall.

No gas canisters are allowed.

Whippets (not the dogs), Chargers (not the phone ones), Balloons, honestly, you will grow out of it. It's a phase.

Keep it family friendly NO Nudity.

Windsor & Eton Pride is **rooted in our local community**. If it were not for partnerships with local organisations who think like we do, this event would not be possible. Pronouns might feel like a lot to learn, but they are simply one of the most powerful ways to show respect. Think of them as the verbal equivalent of getting someone's name right.

Low effort, but high impact.

What are they?

Pronouns are the words we use instead of names (like he, she, or they). Using them correctly ensures everyone feels seen and welcomed.

Common Pronouns

She/Her: Traditionally used by women.

He/Him: Traditionally used by men.

They/Them: Used by many non-binary people, or when you don't know someone's gender. (Yes, the singular "they" is grammatically correct!)

Neopronouns (e.g., ze/zir, xe/xem): Used by individuals who feel these terms best reflect their identity.

Why It Matters

Using the correct pronouns is a fundamental act of kindness. It signals that you respect someone's identity and that they are safe in your community.

What if I make a mistake?

We're all human! If you use the wrong pronoun:

Acknowledge, correct, and move on.

"Actually, she, sorry, they mentioned the meeting is at noon."

Avoid long, dramatic apologies; just aim to get it right next time.

Pro Tips!!!

Don't assume: Appearance doesn't always equal gender.

Listen: Mirror the language people use for themselves.

Ask politely: "What pronouns do you use?" is a perfectly friendly question.

Share yours: Adding your pronouns to your email signature or introductions normalises the practice for everyone.

Pronouns aren't about perfection; they're about making sure everyone is welcomed, safe, and loved for exactly who they are.
